So primary school has ended

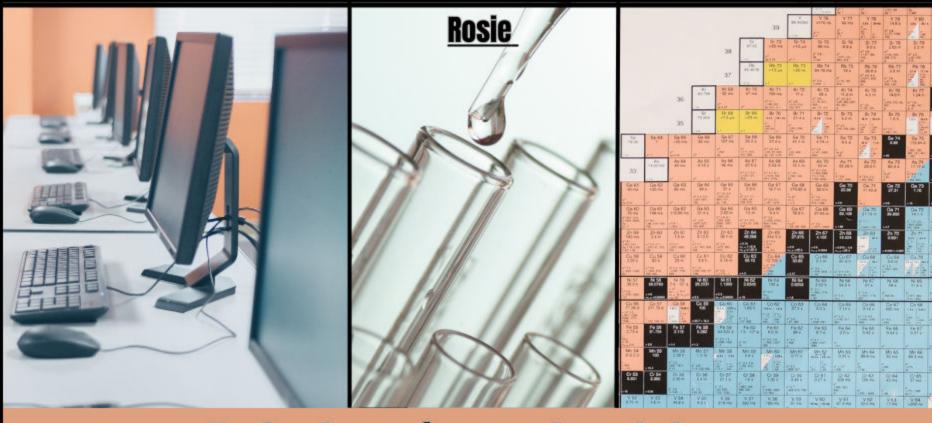
And it's time to turn the page

When you see that girl or guy



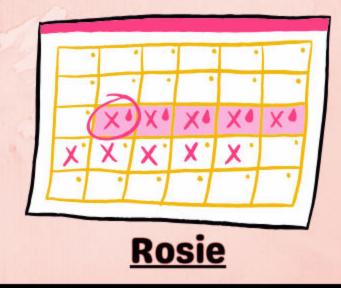


Though periods are normal

This can seem quite an ordeal

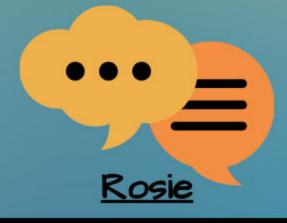


Some young people have acne

As we know, kids can be mean

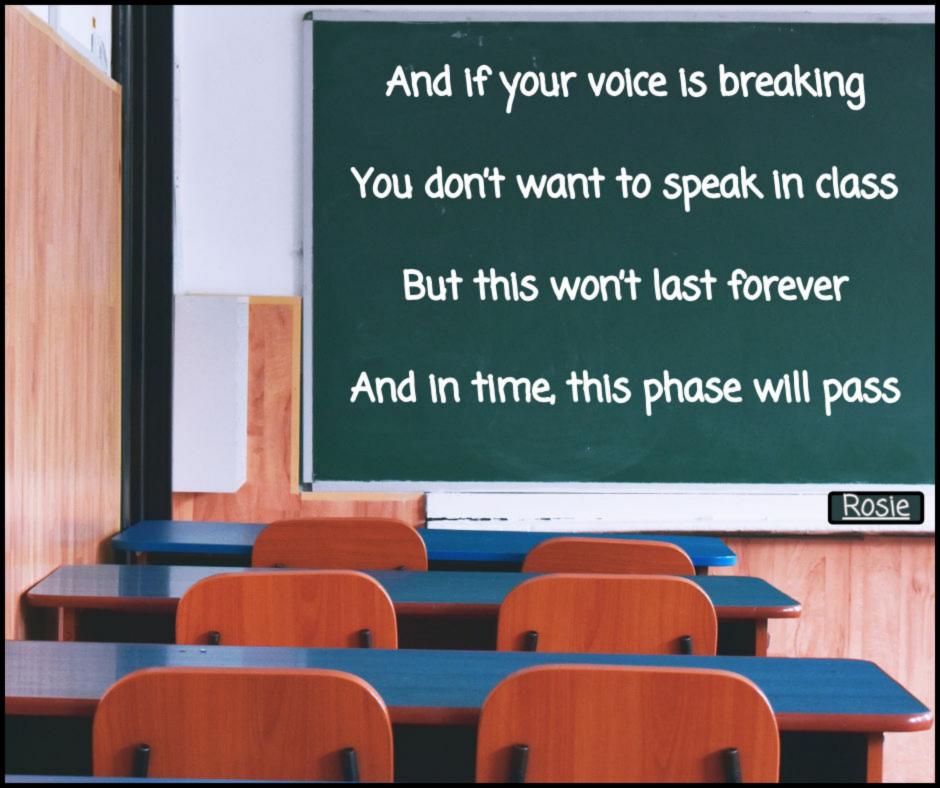


Your facial hair is growing

Are determined by your genes

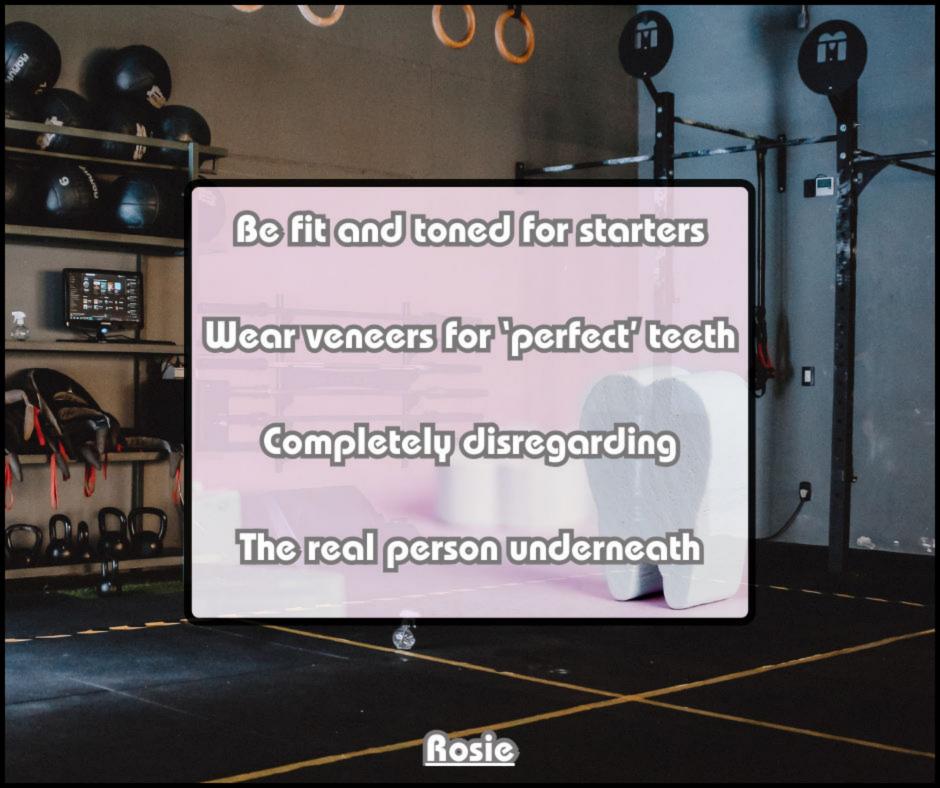

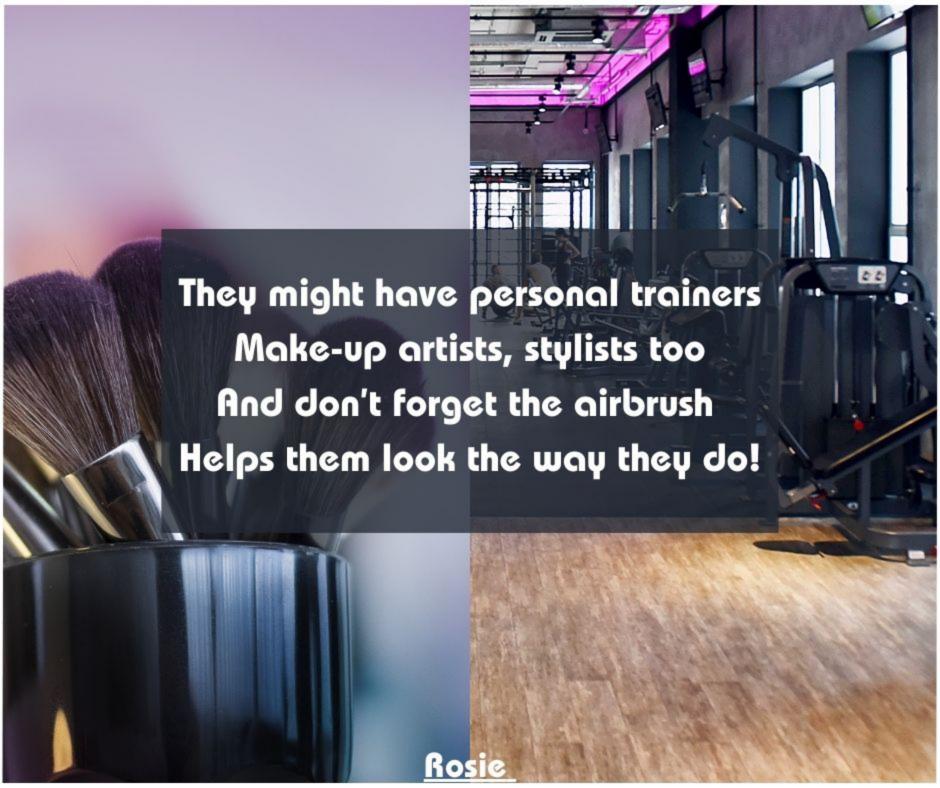
Perfection

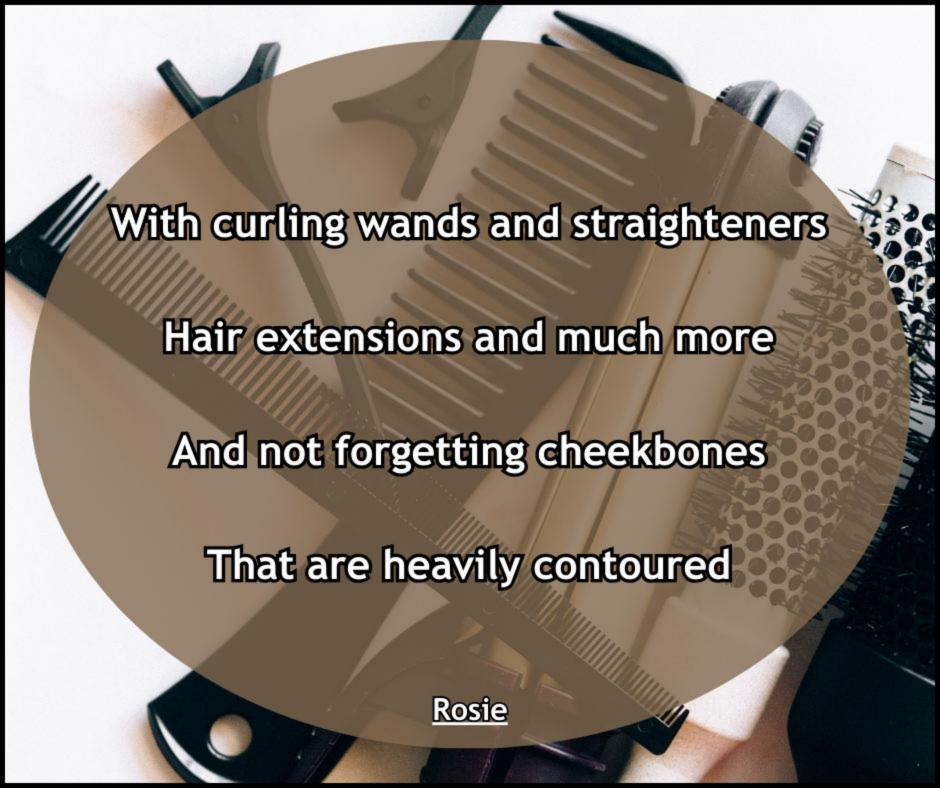
We find in modern culture

And there's no-one else like you

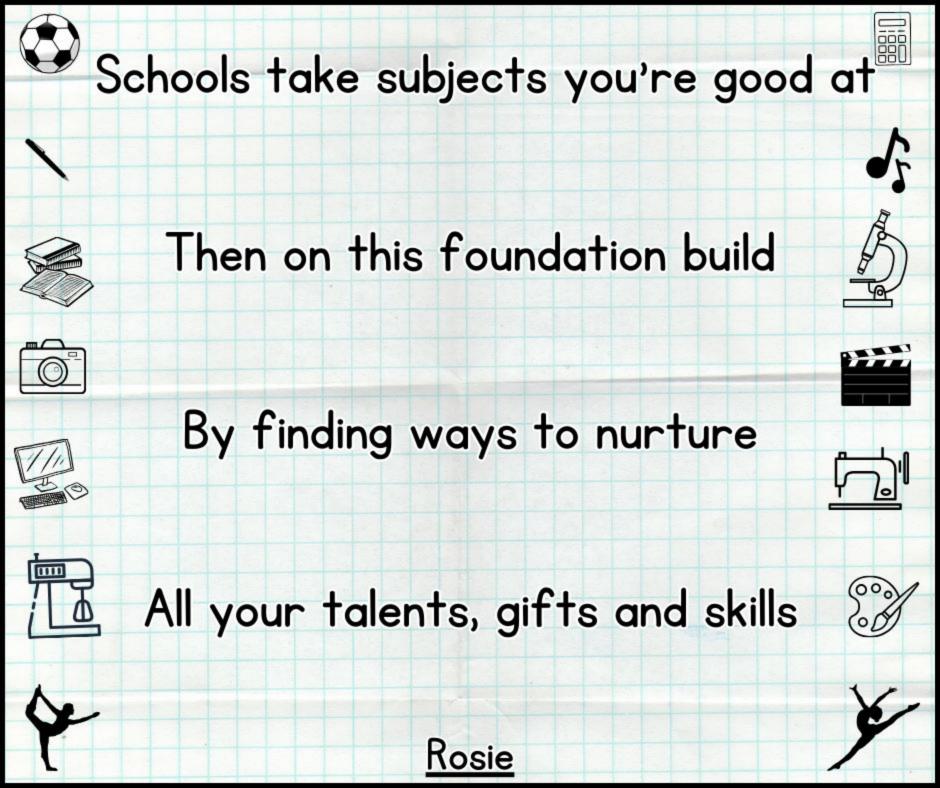

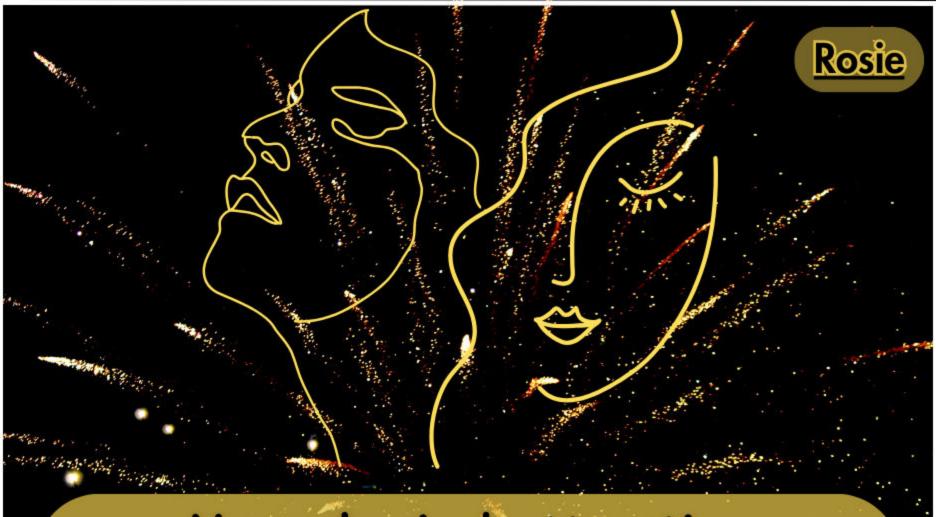

Don't let them push the boundaries

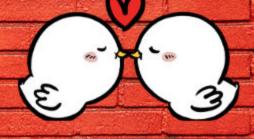
If you're happy with first base

That you're not too happy with

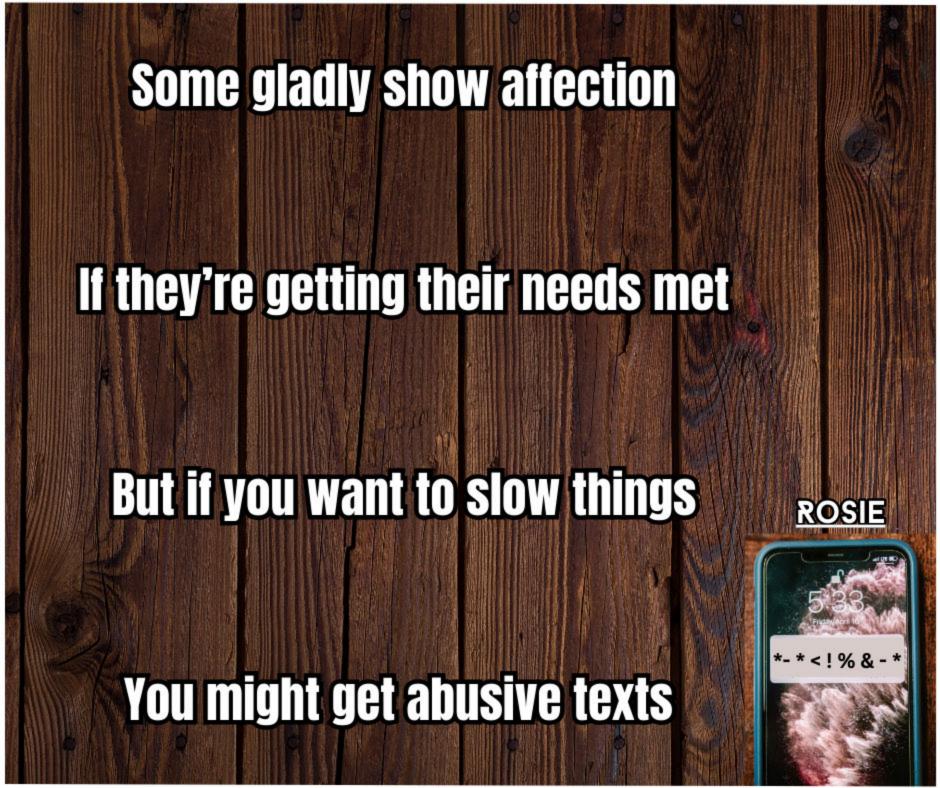
Your body's not their playground

And don't care if it offends

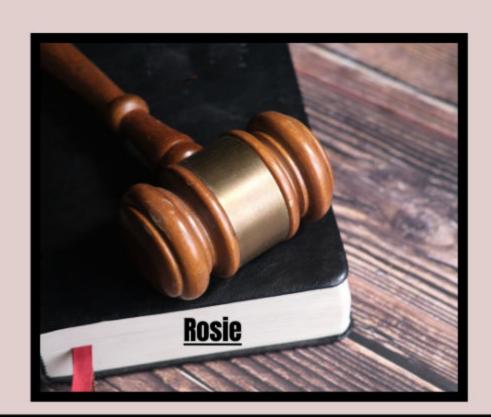
TRUST

Under The Protection Of Children Act 1978
The Criminal Justice Act 1988 &
The Criminal Justice & Courts Act 2015

or threatening to share sexualised
images of a person under the age of 18
is a criminal offence

It's there for your protection Though you might feel guilt and shame You didn't give permission So you're NOT the one to blame

They're jealous of your friendships They don't want you hanging out With anyone besides them And of that, you're in no doubt



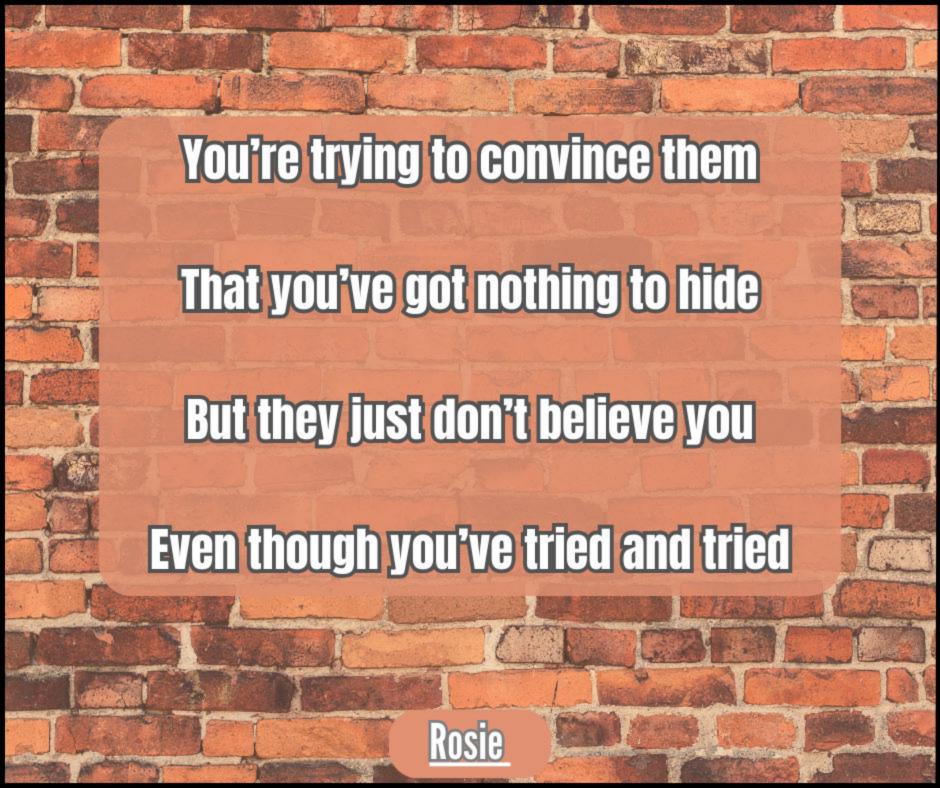


They make you feel so guilty

To that person you belong

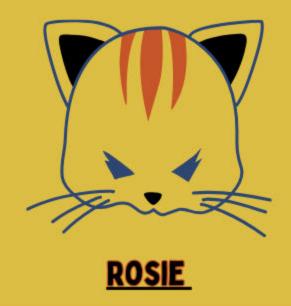

You told them very clearly

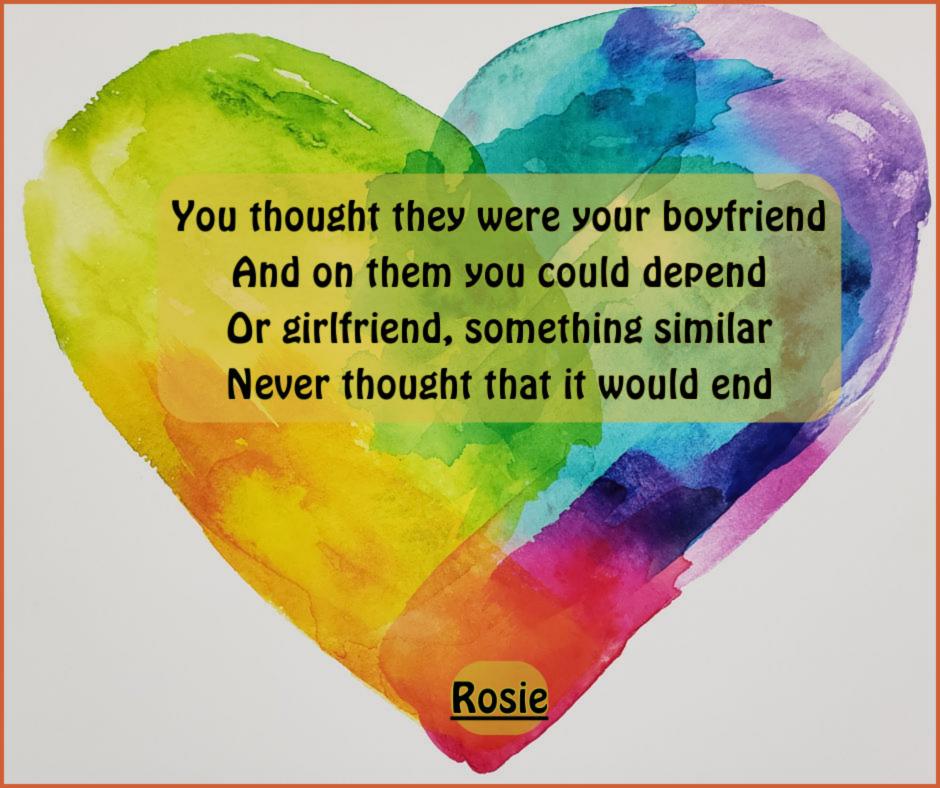
But they won't leave you alone

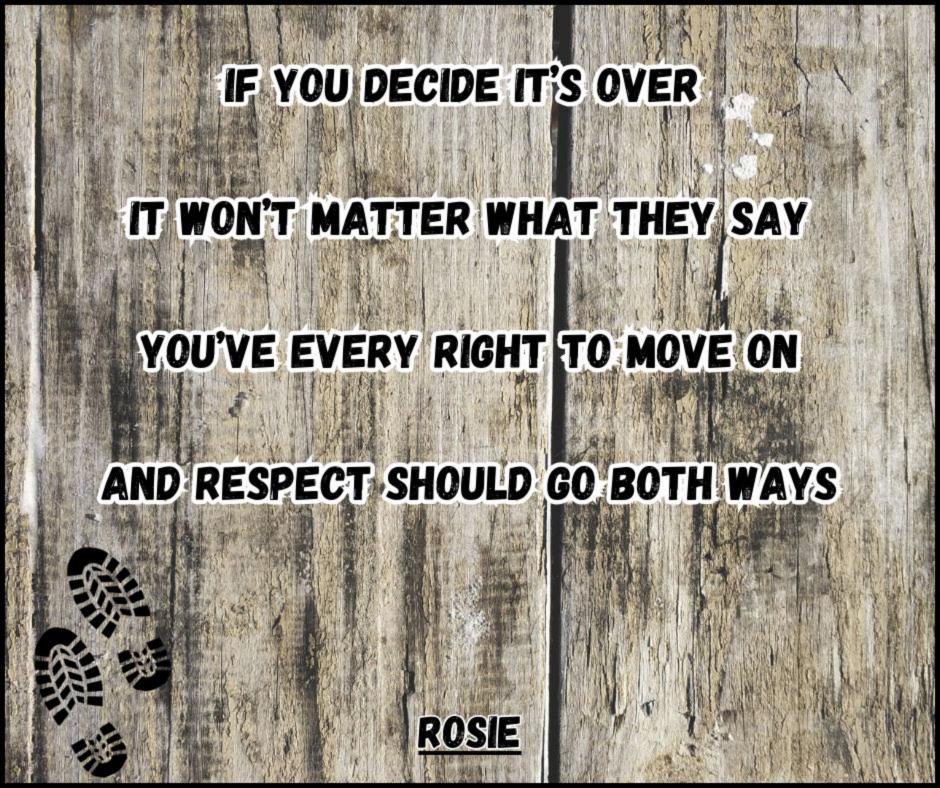
They'll bombard you on 'Insta'

They'll accept you as you are

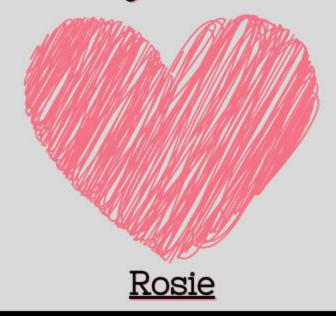

You might question if you should

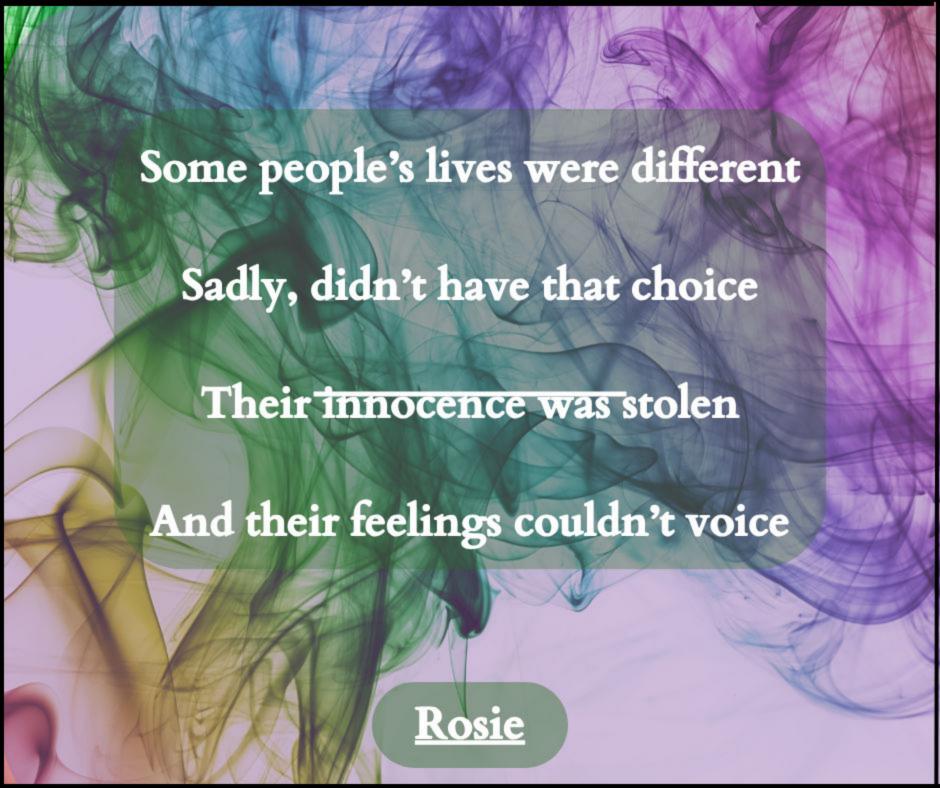
Discuss it with your partner

Can be really hard to face



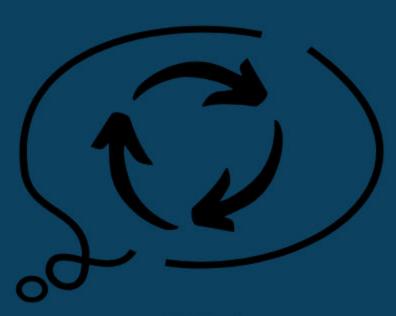

They hide behind a keyboard Introduce themselves to you As someone of your own age But how do you know that's true?

They might strike up a friendship
On a page or site's chat room
But this familiar tactic
Is a way many are groomed

A cyberbully uses

Emails, phone calls and/or texts

Or social media pages

To coerce and to oppress

They'll use intimidation

When online, by using threats

These trolls can be relentless

Which can cause extreme distress

With cyber stalking also
They will follow you online
This unwanted attention
Can cause mental health decline

This internet harassment
When it's used to full effect
Is often so far reaching
Reputations can be wrecked

And this is how they do it
Distributing with intent
Blogs, posts, cruel memes and other
Social media content

Sharing photos and much more This really has an impact As I mentioned just before





Anxiety, depression And low self-esteem result For some, with this behaviour From the taunts and cruel insults

You may be committing a criminal offence if the bullying is causing 'alarm and distress' to the victim (under the Harassment Act 1997).
Or can be considered 'grossly offensive' (Malicious Communications Act 1998 and the Communications Act 2003)

Rosta

Whilst some are posting selfies
On both TikTok and Facebook
There are so many others
Who despise the way they look

Their confidence is shattered
By a bully's nasty words
There's no excuse for cruelty
It's completely undeserved

<u>'Name-calling'</u> <u>Definition:</u>

Abusive language or insults

It can appear to others
On the surface all is well
But looks can be deceiving
There is so much more to tell

You'd never know they're hurting
Some can hide it very well
'You're happy if you're smiling'
Is a myth we must dispel



Quite often we're pretending
When we say that we're just fine
But that just causes problems
For us further down the line

IT'S OK JUST BEING 'YOU'

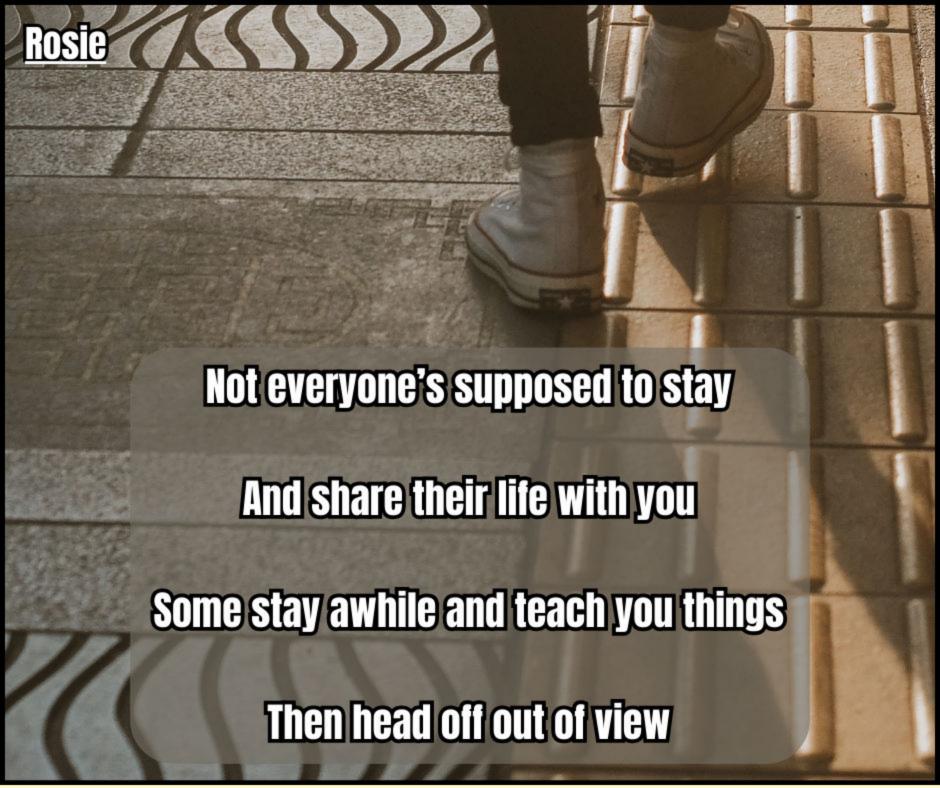
EMBRACE YOUR QUIRKS COMPLETELY

Intrusive thoughts or worries Can be challenging it's true But sharing thoughts and feelings Helps you work all that stuff through







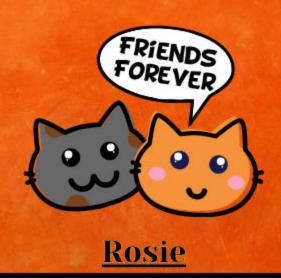
And sadly, there are numbers
